## RECENT EVENTS

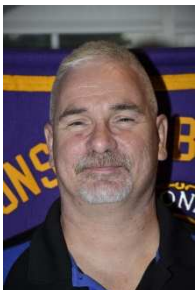


New member Ron Murr was inducted by PID Jim Cavallaro at our last meeting. PDG Dick Wilson was his sponsor.
