In turn, the District Governor Estella passed the banner of the 1st Vice Governor to Springfield while Bill Lavery and Jim Cavallaro look on.

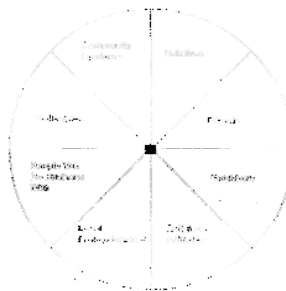
MEET OUR NEW MEMBER
