Put June 2nd on your calendars! The annual chicken BBQ fundraiser is fast approaching and tickets have been distributed Lion Ed Rocco and his team. We are in need of help!! We need you to do two things: First, we need you to sell tickets! This is critical - ticket sales have been decreasing for the past several years – we need to try to reverse that! Remember – SELL, **SELL**, **SELL!!!**

Second, we need everyone work at the event as much as possible – Friday evening, Saturday and Sunday morning. We move the BBQ pit from its storage spot and set it up near the library on Friday, June 1st from 6:30 pm to about 8:30 pm – the more people we have the faster it goes! So far, we have 3! On the day of the event, Saturday June 2nd, there are 3 work periods – 7AM to 12:30PM, 11:30AM to 3:30PM, or 3PM to 6PM.
